

## Kilgore College Core Curriculum\*

The Core Curriculum for Kilgore College is listed below. A core curriculum is defined by the state as curriculum "in the liberal arts, humanities, sciences, and political, social, and cultural history, that all graduates of an institution of higher education are required to complete before receiving a baccalaureate degree." If a student completes the KC Core Curriculum, any state college or university is required to accept it in total. That student, therefore, will not lose any hours in transfer. After completing the Core Curriculum, a student may need only 16 additional hours to receive the associate of arts or associate of science degree. Please see an advisor regarding exact courses needed for a transfer in a specific major to a particular university.
