

Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy

At the end of every fall, spring and summer semester, the Kilgore College Financial Aid Office will be determining which students have not met the requirements of the Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy.

The standards are as follows:

1. If registered for 12 or more hours, must complete at least 9 hours with a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
 2. If registered for 6-11 hours, must complete at least 6 hours with a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
 3. If registered for 1-5 hours, must complete all hours with a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- Students who do not meet these requirements will be placed on either financial aid probation or suspension.
 - Please check your status (probation or suspension) on your Kilgore College Campus Connect page under financial aid. **(Probation Letters will not be mailed to students; it is important that students check their status on Campus Connect!!)**
 - If you have been placed on probation, you may still receive financial aid for the following semester--- but you must meet the above standard at the end of the semester to avoid financial aid suspension in a future semester.
 - If you have been placed on financial aid suspension, all of your financial aid, including loans, will be cancelled for the following semester.
 - If you are placed on financial aid suspension, you will not be able to receive further financial aid (including grants and loans) until you have paid for at least 12 hours and met the standards of the Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy as stated above.
