



## City of Bryan Firefighter/EMT

The City of Bryan Fire Department, a Civil Service department, is currently accepting applications for the position of Firefighter/EMT.

### Minimum Requirements:

- United States citizen.
- Between the ages of 18 and 35.
- Possess a High School diploma or GED, and be able to read and write the English language.
- Basic Firefighter Certification (or certifiable).
- Licensed or certified (or certifiable) EMT through the Texas Department of Health.
- Must meet all legal requirements of the Texas Commission on Fire Protection Personnel Standards and Education.
- Meet the physical standards for the position.
- Possess a valid Class B Exempt Texas Operators License with a good driving record.
- If applicable, discharge from military service must be under honorable conditions.
- No felony convictions or major misdemeanor charges or admissions.
- Good moral character, stable employment history and no history of any conduct which may affect suitability for firefighter work.

### Written Test Date:

Friday, January 30, 2009 @ 1:30 P.M.

Copies of your Firefighter Certification issued by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection and your EMT/Paramedic Certification issued by the Texas Dept of Health **MUST** be turned in at the time of application; otherwise your application will be considered incomplete.
