High school diploma or equivalent. Texas Commission on Fire Protection basic firefighter certification and Texas Department of State Health Services (TDSHS) EMT-Basic certification required. May be required to obtain Texas Department of State Health Services EMT-Paramedic certification and other specialized training to meet the needs of the Fire Department. Ability to pass Fire Department physical ability test, and the NFPA 1582 Pre-Employment Physical. Valid Texas driver's license with driving record that meets City guidelines. Valid Texas Class B driver's license required within six (6) months of date of employment.
