The Presidential Scholarship is designed to attract academically superior students to Kilgore College.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

1. To be eligible to apply, high school seniors must meet at least two of the following three criteria.
 - A. Enhanced ACT composite score of 25 or SAT composite score of 1650 or above.
 - B. High School grade average of 92 or higher.
 - C. High School class rank in upper 10% of graduation class.
2. Deadline for applying for the scholarship is February 1 of each year. (Scores for ACT tests taken in February and SAT tests taken in January will be accepted until March 1.)
3. The Kilgore College Scholarship Committee will review, evaluate, select, and notify recipients no later than April 1.
4. Recipients must notify the committee, in writing, by May 1 of their intention to accept the scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE AND CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY

The Presidential Scholarship provides tuition, fees and use of books. Accepting this scholarship also creates the following obligations on the part of the student.

1. Awards are made for one (1) semester, with a review at the end of each semester. Recipients must maintain a 3.3 GPA with a minimum course load of 15 hours per semester.
2. Recipients must attend a function hosted by the President of Kilgore College each fall.
3. Each recipient must exhibit satisfactory personal conduct as outlined in the KC Student Handbook.
4. At the end of the spring semester, recipients must submit a "renewal application" for the next year.
5. Recipients of this award may accept other Kilgore College institutional scholarships to cover the cost of room and board in college housing. They may accept scholarships from other sources.

Scholarships are based upon academic performance and require that the student meet the requirements as listed. Not more than sixty (60%) of the courses in a student's semester schedule shall be in a single discipline. Scholarship renewals and applications require that the student comply with the conditions of the agreement and that satisfactory progress be demonstrated toward earning a degree or certificate.

The scholarship covers four long semesters (2 fall and 2 spring). Any exception to this policy must be approved by the Kilgore College Scholarship Committee. Should the student withdraw from school or drop below the minimum class load, the scholarship will be recovered through any refunds due the student.
