OLD MAIN

Schedule and Results:

Renovation began in October 2004 and is scheduled for completion in August 2005.

The interior will be stripped to the original brick walls constructed in 1936.

With the exception of new energy-efficient windows, the exterior will remain essentially unchanged. However, the interior will be gutted and then completely rebuilt to 21st Century specifications.

When completed the building will have 23,488 square feet of usable instructional space.

OLD MAIN will once again become the premiere classroom facility on campus.

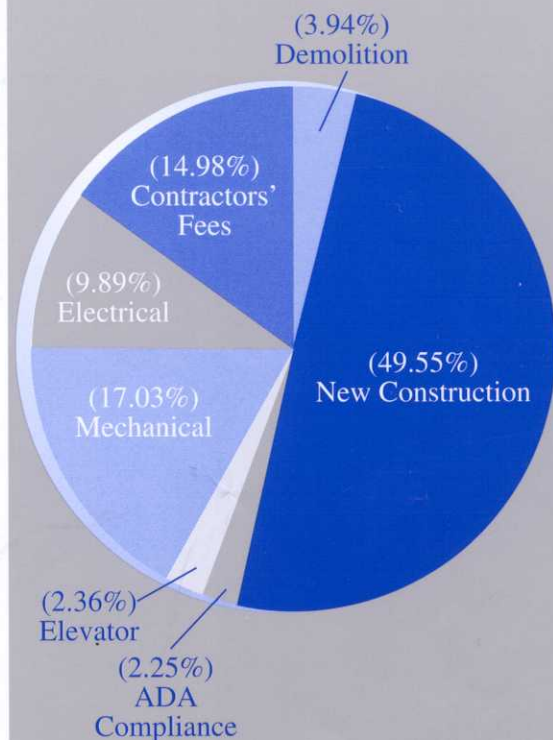
Fourteen classrooms and 28 faculty offices will be constructed with state-of-the-art furnishings and teaching aids.

One classroom will be restored as a "Legacy Room" and will look as it originally did in 1936.
