Competent and Professional Student Writers

Faculty Development – pedagogy training for adjuncts & full-time

Benchmark “cap tests” for core curriculum

Assess student learning styles at entry and implement variety of options

Enhance orientation – study skills training prior to college coursework

Address student engagement deficiencies – use CCSSE

Student engagement through service learning/community projects (give coursework real meaning to a life well lived)

Developmental math – innovate to get students through it and ready for college work (2 people)

Implement learning communities (from 4 people)

Peer Mentoring/tutoring in learning communities (specific to one)

Lab dedicated to academic work and separate lab for recreational use

Mandatory information literacy class

Centralized tutoring plus testing center staffed by professionals (Bachelor’s Degree minimum)

Implement supplemental instruction (SI) to assist with “bottleneck courses”

Linking retention/graduation to learning outcomes

Classroom communication with students – different teaching techniques for different students

Learning to learn – college-success plan with assigned mentor, follow through (academic or degree contract)
