★ ★ TESTING REQUIREMENTS ★ ★

The Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requires that all students seeking to enroll in college-level courses be assessed in the basic skill areas of reading, writing, and mathematics prior to enrolling in college coursework, unless exempt. THEA and ACCUPLACER are the tests KC uses to assess incoming students. Students may take college-level courses related to the area(s) of the test they pass and will be required to enroll in developmental education in areas that are not passed. Exemptions from testing do not override course or program prerequisites; therefore, placement testing may be required. For more information, contact the Testing Center located on the Kilgore Campus at (903) 983-8215 or KC-Longview at (903) 753-2642.

★ ★ WITHDRAWING FROM ENROLLMENT ★ ★

- The student is personally responsible for withdrawing from enrollment without a grade in the Office of Admissions and Records prior to the first day of the semester and through the 4th class day of the semester. After that time, the student withdraws from enrollment in the Counseling Center with a grade of "W" through July 1 for Summer I and August 5 for Summer II. Mini/flex class withdrawal dates vary (see Mini/Flex refund schedule and drop dates on p. 12-14).
- Students who fail to officially withdraw on a timely basis may receive a grade of "F" for the semester. Students may receive no refund and may be liable for return of financial aid.

SCHEDULE OF REFUNDS FOR SUMMER 2010

- You are a transfer student, have submitted documentation of test scores or exemption from testing, and have no developmental requirements or holds. Please allow at least two weeks for processing of your application/transcripts before attempting to web register.
