Maintain required regulatory records and documentation for; OSHA, EPA
Support of all safety and health programs for all employees in the manufacturing facility
Provide OSHA regulatory training to hourly employees and supervisors as well as orientation to all new hires
Onsite Emergency Responder requiring 24 hour a day availability by cell phone
Coordinate exposure monitoring schedules. Act as liaison to supervision and personnel for exposure monitoring results, recommendations, and control strategies
Distribute weekly/monthly statistical health and safety reports to supervision/senior management
Ensure required emergency response planning has been conducted and implemented
Interface with supervisors and managers regarding health and safety matters
Provide employee and supervisor training on OSHA regulations; Hazard Communication, Personal Protective
Work directly with the Workers Comp team on effectively returning employees to work after a work related injury
