

**Kilgore College**  
**Admission Requirements for Financial Aid Eligibility**

Students who apply to Kilgore College will be required to submit the following documents:

1. An admissions application, through the ApplyTexas electronic application system
2. An official high school/home school transcript, passing GED scores, and/or official college transcripts
3. Proof of Texas residency for the previous 12 months (to qualify for in-state tuition)

Financial aid eligibility requires all current official transcripts be on file in the Registrar's Office. Financial Aid will only be awarded to students whose files are complete in the Office of Admissions, Registrar's Office, and the Financial aid office.

**General Eligibility Requirements for Title IV Student Aid**

1. Must be a U. S. citizen, or eligible non-citizen.
2. Must have a high school or home school diploma which has been evaluated and accepted by the Registrar's office as valid - or
3. Must have a GED on file, showing all sections as Passed.
4. Be enrolled in a school or college which participates in the federal financial aid programs.
5. Be enrolled in a Title IV eligible program, and be working toward a degree, certificate, or transferable program.
6. Be in compliance with the Satisfactory Academic Progress policy, as set forth by the financial aid SAP policy, and be making Sap each semester.
7. Cannot owe an overpayment on any Title IV fund from KC or any previously attended institution.
8. May not be in default on any Title IV Federal Loan, including Federal Stafford Loans, Perkins Loans, PLUS Loans, or any other HEA Loan received at any institution
9. Must be registered with Selective Service, (if a male between the ages of 18 and 25).
