



East Texas Regional Science Fair (ETRSF) Schedule

7:30 to 9 a.m. Arrival and Project Set-up; Safety check by the SRC committee

The ETRSF will be held in the Devall Ballroom of the Charles K. and Lyde Devall Student Center at the corner of Elder St. and Broadway Blvd. on the Kilgore College campus. Students and teachers can be dropped off at the corner of Elder St. and East South St. However, buses and vans should park in the lot south of the East Texas Oil Museum, which is located at the corner of US Hwy 259 and Ross Ave. During this time, parents are free to walk through the science fair and view projects.

9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Judging of projects

Students should be near their projects from 9 to 11:30 a.m. Parents and teachers should not be near projects during this period when judges can interview students. Students are free from 11:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. and can take part in other activities: Starbucks (closes at 1:30 p.m.), Rangerette Museum (closes at 2 p.m.), East Texas Oil Museum (small fee, closes at 5 p.m.), science videos are planned for the Canterbury ES Building, Kilgore Bowling Center (fee, noon to midnight; 2004 S. Henderson Blvd); several restaurants are in the area.

2 to 3 p.m. Take projects down

Projects that are left after this time will be discarded. Facilities management needs to prepare the ballroom for other activities that are scheduled for the same weekend.

3 to 4 p.m. Free time

One possibility: Walk across the bridge to the east side of campus and stroll through the Shakespeare Garden. Also, if it's open, visit the art museum outside of Van Cliburn Auditorium across the street from the garden.

4 to 5 p.m. Awards Presentation

Awards will be presented in Dodson Auditorium, between Houston and Nolen streets off of US Hwy 259.
