Phlebotomy - PLAB 1023 and PLAB 1060 Clinical

Spring Classes: January 3, 2023- April 6, 2023

Classroom: 4:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on Tuesdays & Thursday for first 7 weeks

Classroom when clinicals begin: 4:30 p.m. to 9:30 pm on Tuesdays

Clinicals: Assigned 100 hours starting after week 7, usually meets between Monday-Friday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., about 20 hours per week

13 weeks, 200 hours, \$875 (\$480 classroom tuition, \$365 clinical tuition and \$30 required insurance)

The Phlebotomy program at Kilgore College is selecting applicants to enter the Summer class. Students will learn proper venipuncture techniques. Students completing the Phlebotomy training will test for the American Society of Phlebotomy Technicians national certification. Additional expenses include the required textbook \$165, national exam fee \$90, drug screen and background check \$46, Scantrons, clinical attire \$80, documentation of vaccinations. CPR certification will be given in class and the fee is \$40.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Minimum age of 18 years old prior to first class day
- Minimum education of high school diploma or GED

Selection Process

There is a selection process to get into the Phlebotomy class for the Summer class.

The first step is for an applicant to schedule and take the Workkeys assessment.

- **Students must score 4 or higher on each of the three assessment areas to receive an interview.** Workkeys assessments are given at both the Longview and Kilgore Campuses. To register for the assessment at the Kilgore campus call **903-983-8215** for information on registering for the assessments given on Thursdays at 10 am. The fee for the assessment test is \$50 and must be paid in advance.

To register for the assessment at the Longview campus, one must go to the campus located at 300 S. High St. in Longview and bring their Driver's License at least 24 hours in advance. Tests are given on Tuesdays at 2 pm and Thursdays at 9 am. To call for more information on the assessments at the Longview campus, call 903--236-2051 or schedule online at

Items needed if selected into the Phlebotomy program:

Individuals invited to enter the program will be considered pre-admission until **after** providing these required documents: All documents must be turned in by Friday, before the first class day.

- Copy of birth certificate or driver's license
- Copy of high school diploma, transcript or GED
- Documentation of all required basic or childhood immunizations including a current negative Tuberculosis Skin test, documentation of starting or completing the Hepatitis B vaccination and a current flu shot.
- A current negative drug test
- A current clear background check

Deadline to turn in all paperwork and pay is: December 8, 2022.
