PTCB Exam

(Pharmacy Technician Certification Board)

General Information:

- The Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) determines which candidates are authorized to take an exam.
- Authorization period is valid for 90 days.
- Cost is \$129 and is paid at the time of registration.
- All PTCB exams must be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance.

Registration and Scheduling Options:

Candidates must apply for the test. Once the application is approved, the candidate may request an appointment for testing by:

Retesting:

Candidates must contact PTCB to reapply. All retake policies are enforced by PTCB.

Test Information:

- Candidates will have 110 minutes to complete this exam.
- Candidates receive a preliminary pass/fail result onscreen immediately after they complete the end-ofexam survey.
- Candidates also receive a printout with their preliminary pass or fail status.
