The ATI TEAS exam is offered every **Thursday at 9:00am by appointment only** except during late registration periods and college closings

You must follow these procedures in order to properly register for testing:

- Pay the non-refundable \$115.00 testing fee in person at the Kilgore College - Longview Cashier's Office, Credit Card by Phone, or Submit the appointment request form and payment online at the <u>Scheduling and payment portal</u>
- Create a student account at <u>www.atitesting.com</u> at least 24 hours prior to arriving to test. You will not be able to login for testing without your ATI username and password and you will be required to reschedule your exam.



On Test Day:

- 1. Arrive at least 15 minutes early to sign in for exam. Students arriving late will be rescheduled.
- 2. Provide an **unexpired government issued** photo identification.

About the Test:

- The test is administered in the Longview Testing Center, located in the Hendrix Building # 1 Room 210.
- The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) version 7 is a multiple-choice assessment of basic academic knowledge in Reading, Mathematics, Science, English and Language Usage.
- The TEAS exam is electronically timed and usually lasts 3½ hours. Only the calculator that is embedded within the exam may be used.
- Test accommodation requests must be made through the Disability Services Office at least 48 hours prior
 to your desired test date by completing the "Accommodation Request" form. Once completed, submit the
 signed form to the Testing Center at least 48 hours prior to your desired test date
- Study material is available at http://www.atitesting.com/ati_store/product.aspx?zpid=1194.
- Students will receive a copy of his/her scores immediately following test administration and may access scores at any time through their ATI student account.

General Information:

- Cell phones and other cellular devices are strictly prohibited in the testing center and must be powered off.
- Testing fees are non-refundable and receipts are only valid for 90 days from the payment date. Be sure you need this exam before you pay and schedule it
- Students should refer to the program to which he/she is applying for retesting and admission policies.
