### TICKET PURCHASING

Tournament tickets will be sold at the gate. Cash and card will be accepted. Instructions and purchase site information will be listed on the tournament home page site. Directions and instructions will also be given upon entering the gym.

Ticket prices for each session will be (\$12) adults, (\$8) for students (must present a student ID)

A tournament pass will be available for (\$40).

Pass lists will not be utilized for the tournament.

Session 1 games are at 1:00 and 3:00 PM, Session 2 games are at 6:00 and 8:00 PM each day except for Championship Saturday. Session 1 on Saturday will be 4:00 PM. Session 2 will be at 7:00 PM.

**Please note: The gym will be cleared between all sessions to allow for cleaning and sanitation procedures, and to allow as many fans as possible to attend their team's games.**

### AWARDS

The awards ceremony will be conducted at center court immediately following the conclusion of the championship games. We ask teams to return to the bench area as soon as possible at the conclusion of the game so that the ceremony can proceed.

### ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

All-Tournament Teams will be selected according to Region XIV Guidelines. Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the respective championship games.

## **BRACKET**

The higher seed team will be designated the home team. When facing the front of the scorer's table, the home team will occupy the bench to the left and will wear white/light jerseys. If equal seed are playing, then the team on the top of the bracket is designated as the home team and will wear white/light jerseys.

## **SPORTS MEDICINE**

## **CHEER TEAMS, BANDS AND ARTIFICIAL NOISEMAKERS**

Cheer Teams are allowed during tournament games. However, we ask to please refrain from pounding megaphones on the floor. Cheer teams should arrive in uniform as there will not be additional locker rooms available. All Cheer Teams **in uniform** will be admitted to the tournament for free.

Consistent with NCAA rules, bands will be allowed and will be limited 29 band members and one band director.

No air horns or artificial noisemakers of any kind are allowed.

## **CONCESSIONS**

Concessions will be available throughout the tournament.

## **CREDENTIALS**

Credentials will be issued according to the request forms sent out prior to the tournament. All coaches, managers, athletic training staff, athletic directors, presidents and media will be provided credentials. **ALL OTHERS MUST PURCHASE TICKETS**. For security reasons, credentials must be worn at all times while inside the Gymnasium.

## **DRESSING ROOMS**

Upon arrival at The Arena, you will be directed to the appropriate locker room. Locker rooms will be rotated between teams. Your locker room will be locked when you are not in the room. Please ensure that you remove all team and personal gear after your game so our staff will have the opportunity to clean and disinfect prior to the arrival of the next team.

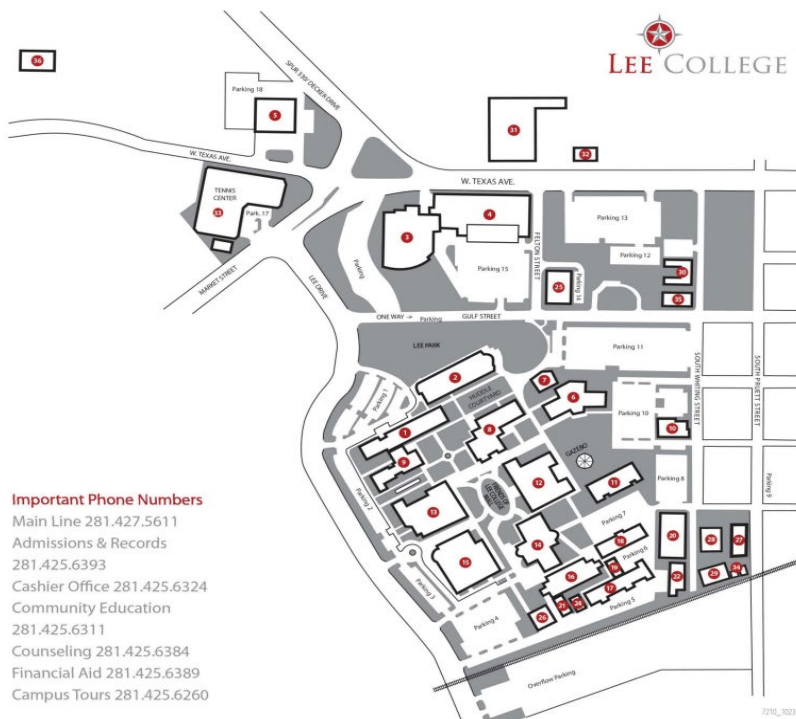
## **EMERGENCIES**

## **HALFTIME**

As per conference rules, the length of halftime in Region XIV Tournament games is 15 minutes, rather than the 12 minutes that are used during the regular season.

## **MEDIA**

All media must present verifiable Region XIV credentials to be admitted to the tournament. All media must vacate in a timely manner so the next games' media will have adequate time to get seated.

## **OFFICIALS**

Officials will be selected and assigned by the current Region XIV Basketball Commissioner, Tony Stigliano.

## **PRACTICE**

Shoot-around times have been predetermined and are attached to this packet. Shoot arounds will be closed to the public and media unless otherwise designated by the tournament director. All practices shall be timed by the scoreboard clock beginning at the scheduled practice time, regardless of whether the team has taken the floor. Teams must be leaving the court when their time expires. If a team arrives early, it may take the floor as soon as it is available, but will still be limited to the scheduled amount of time. If the team arrives early, any team activity taking place in the playable area will designate the start of shoot-around and the clock will begin. The Arena is not available for practices prior to the listed times. Teams arriving in Baytown early should make their own arrangements for practice locations.

## **PRE-GAME**

Teams will be provided no less than 25 minutes for warm-up between games.

30:00 - Warm-up

12:00 - Officials on court

5:00 - National Anthem (first game of each session) Visiting team introductions (starters and coaches) Home team introductions (starters and coaches)

- For the first game of each day, the teams will not be allowed on the floor until 30-minutes prior to game time.

### **ACCESS TO THE COURT**

Teams should enter and exit the court using the tunnels adjacent to the court. **DO NOT CLIMB THE WALLS OR THE RAILS.**

### **RADIO/INTERNET**

Radio/Internet broadcast may be aired or streamed on the internet. There will be access to Wi- Fi only. All games will be streamed on

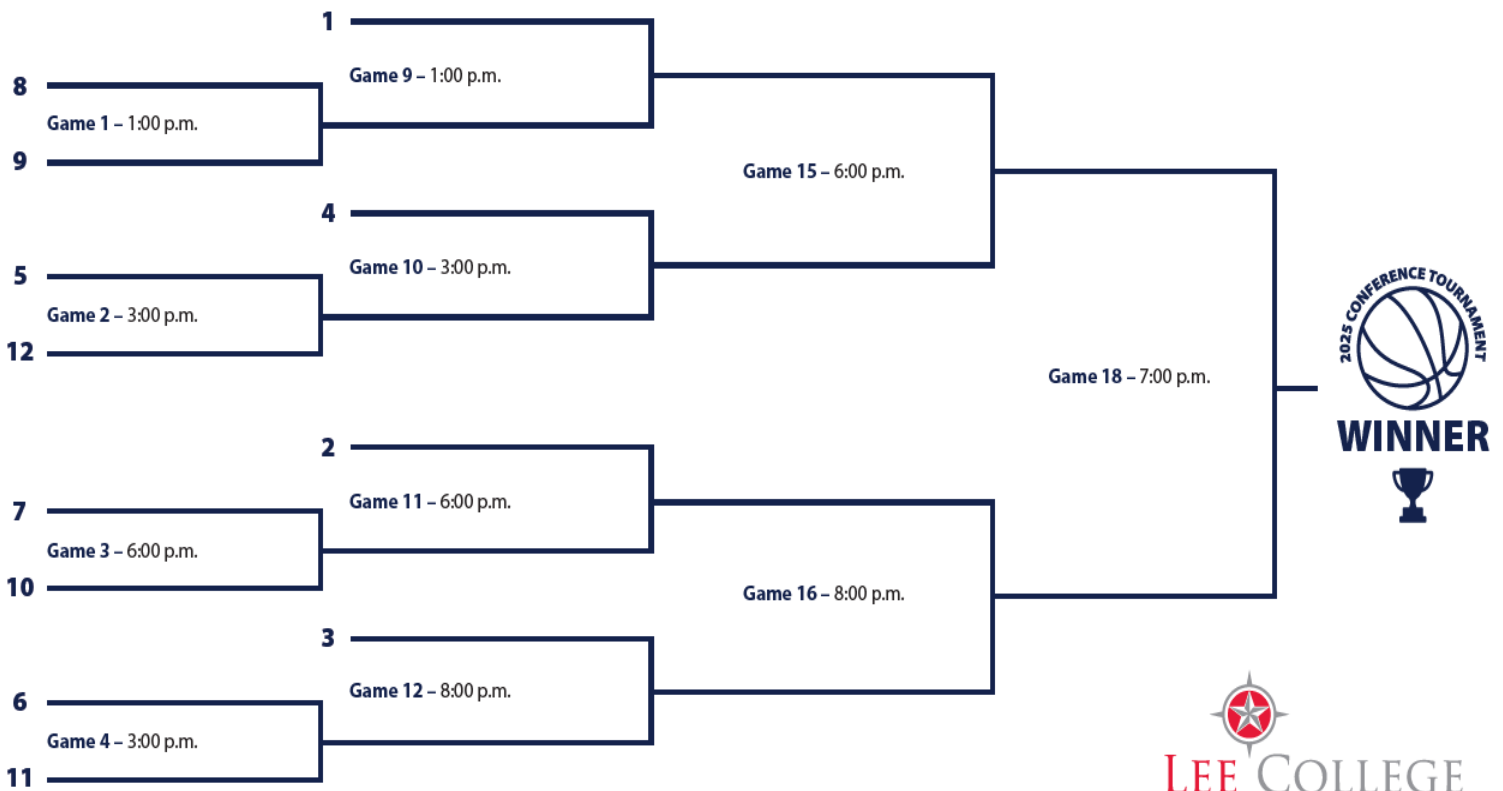
