Phlebotomy- FALL

The Phlebotomy program accepts approximately 14 students per course. Phlebotomy is the process of making a puncture in a vein, usually in the arm, with a cannula for the purpose of drawing blood. Students will learn proper venipuncture techniques. Students completing the Phlebotomy course are eligible to sit for the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) Certification.
