



Minimum Expectations for Students Entering the Surgical Technology Program

The Kilgore College Surgical Technology Program is a rigorous healthcare training program designed to prepare students for entry-level practice as surgical technologists. Students accepted into the program are expected to meet the following minimum standards for academic performance, professional conduct, and physical ability.

Academic Expectations

- Demonstrate the ability to read, comprehend, and apply complex medical terminology and surgical concepts.
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress according to program policies.
- Complete assigned coursework, exams, and laboratory activities on time.
- Utilize critical thinking and problem-solving skills during classroom, laboratory, and clinical experiences.
- Follow all policies outlined in the Kilgore College Catalog and Surgical Technology Student Handbook.

Professional Conduct Expectations

- Treat patients, faculty, staff, and clinical personnel with respect and professionalism.
- Maintain patient confidentiality in accordance with HIPAA regulations.
- Demonstrate honesty and integrity in academic and clinical settings.
- Follow all institutional and clinical site policies.
- Maintain appropriate professional appearance according to program dress code.

Clinical Expectations

- Punctuality, attend and actively participate in all assigned clinical rotations.
- Follow sterile technique and operating room protocols.



- Demonstrate safe patient care practices.
- Complete required surgical case experiences as outlined by program accreditation standards.
- Accept constructive feedback from instructors and clinical preceptors.

Physical and Mental Requirements

- Stand for extended periods of time (often 2–10hours).
- Lift and move equipment and supplies up to approximately 25 pounds.
- Demonstrate manual dexterity necessary to handle surgical instruments.
- Visually identify surgical anatomy, instruments, and sterile field breaks.
- Function effectively in high-stress and fast-paced environments.
- Communicate clearly with members of the surgical team.
