Ranger Ambassador Job Description

Qualifications

- A. Be enrolled at least full-time (12 credit hours/semester)
- B. Maintain a 2.5 or higher cumulative and semester GPA. If the 2.5 GPA is not maintained, the Ranger Ambassador will be placed on probation for one semester. The Ranger Ambassador will still receive the semester scholarship, and be expected to perform all required duties. If the GPA is not brought up to the minimum requirement by the following semester, the Ranger Ambassador may be released from the program.
- C. Commit to at least one year of service (fall and spring semester)
- D. Be available for 5 hours of work per week during business hours, in addition to various events which might fall outside of college business hours.
- E. Exhibit leadership potential, and an outgoing, friendly personality.
- F. Be in good academic and disciplinary standing with Kilgore College.
- G. Be able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing with a diverse group of people and personalities.
- H. Have basic computer skills and the ability to learn new systems/software for use in prospective student communication.
- I. Be able to climb stairs, walk campus, and lift up to 25 lbs.

Terms & Conditions of the Position

A. Length of term

1. Nine months of service beginning August 24th. This includes one fall and one spring semester.
2. Required event attendance as scheduled (including, but not limited to)
 - a. Ranger Ambassador training
 - b. Greater East Texas College Night
 - c. Ranger Preview Day(s)
 - d. KC sporting events
 - e. Graduation ceremonies

B. Training (including, but not limited to)

1. Kilgore College history, traditions, and mission
2. Driver safety
3. Team building
4. Marketing approaches
5. Academic departments
6. Student services
7. Campus tour fundamentals/script/route



C. Scholarship

1. \$750 scholarship per long semester, disbursed at the successful completion of the 16-week term. Should ambassadors be dismissed before the end of the semester, the scholarship will be awarded based on the number of weeks completed.

D. Attire/Personal Presentation

1. Ranger Ambassadors will be provided one uniform polo, one program t-shirt, and an array of KC t-shirts from the Admissions Office. Pants or shorts must be provided by the student. Appropriate attire will be determined prior to events or special functions. A uniform polo, ambassador t-shirt, or KC t-shirt must be worn when on duty at the Visitor Center.
2. As a representative of KC, every Ranger Ambassador is expected to present a professional image reflected in attitude, speech, and dress.
3. Ranger Ambassadors are expected to follow the KC employee dress code as laid out in the KC employee handbook.

E. Conduct

1. Ranger Ambassadors are representatives of KC and are expected to present exemplary behavior during all working hours. This includes, but is not limited to: timeliness, positive attitude, and professionalism
2. Any violation of the KC Student Code of Conduct may result in expulsion from the Ranger Ambassador program and revocation of the semester scholarship.

Responsibilities

A. Tour Duties

1. Conduct well-organized, friendly tours of KC for parents, prospective students, and other visitors.
2. Become well-versed in KC history, tradition, general information, etc, for answering questions on tours and at the Visitor Center.
3. Memorize tour script and tour route.
4. Represent all areas and organizations of KC equally and accurately to tour participants.

B. Recruitment Duties

1. Serve as a positive representative for KC to prospective students and be accessible to answer questions.
2. Understand and use KC enrollment goals and marketing messages when interacting with prospective students and parents.
3. Interact with faculty and staff involved in the recruitment of students.
4. Participate in on or off campus recruiting (transportation may/may not be provided) and one-on-one or electronic (phone, email, etc.) contact with prospective students.

C. Ambassador Duties

1. Represent KC at events as assigned.
2. Participate in all assigned duties with a positive attitude and take initiative with unanticipated tasks or problems.



D. Administrative Duties

1. Assist in operation of the Visitor Center as assigned.
2. Assist in compiling event materials as assigned.
3. Maintain communication with Ranger Ambassador sponsor about situations that warrant his/her attention.
4. Other duties as assigned.

Reporting Structure

- A. The Ranger Ambassador program is an extension of Office of Admissions within the Division of Student Services
- B. Ranger Ambassadors report to the assigned staff sponsor, who reports to the Director of Admissions.
